Engineered Solutions Tier I

 Implements cost-effective, comprehensive efficiency projects through expertguided services



Customers can receive incentives to shorten payback time by 3 to 6 years, covering audit and engineering fees paid directly to the Program Ally



Engineered Solutions Tier II

- Designed for large C&l customers
- Supports multi-measure energy-efficient projects

Up to 60% of project cost covered Energy savings with incentives for:

Confirm upgrades, submit for incentives, and save on your energy bills



Customer Participation and Support

Engineered Solutions Tier I

Who should participate?

- All MUSH (municipal, university, school, and hospital customers with a minimum peak demand of 300 kW (exceptions for multiple buildings)
- C&I, multifamily, and non-profit customers in underserved areas (OBC, UEZ, OZ) with a minimum peak demand of 300 kW and/or 40,000 therms annually (exceptions apply)
- >500,000 kWh in first year project savings
- At least two electric energy efficiency measures
- Projects must pass NJ Benefit Cost Test



Incentives are available for their services

Engineered Solutions Tier II

Who should participate?

- All C&I buildings including MUSH with a minimum peak demand of 300 kW (exceptions apply)
- 200,000 kWh in first year project savings
- At least two electric energy efficiency measures (one non-lighting measure)
